

The Gospel of John – two books in one: the ‘Book of The Seven Signs’ (left circle) and the ‘Book of The Passion’ (right circle)

In Seven Sections (with twelve parts per section) the writer reveals that Jesus, by his Ministry, Death & Resurrection, completes Judaism: though the Jews were unable, from the beginning, to recognise him as the Messiah, Son of God, Spirit-baptiser and Saviour of the world; the Greeks (the gentiles) were believing in his signs and ready to receive eternal life, even, at the last - in very great number!
